



Routine maintenance of Kalor wood pellet stoves - performed by owner/user

By way of example only, we list the typical procedure below, of the maintenance operations carried out on a day-to-day basis:

Important: All maintenance should be carried out when the stove is cold

1.	Open front door to gain access to combustion chamber	2.	Remove ash pan and empty. Ashes can be spread on your lawn and is an excellent fertilizer	
3.	Remove burnpot, clean and ensure that all holes/slots are clear	4.	Remove top baffle from "roof" of combustion chamber	
5.	Vacuum thoroughly the combustion chamber and area above the baffle	6.	Clean the heat exchanger tubes using hand or the tool provided. This is often hidden behind grill near top of stove.	
7.	Check air intake pipe and vents in room and ensure that they are clear	8.	Replace all parts and close door tightly	

It is recommended that the above procedure is carried out on a daily base throughout the heating season. The more often you clean your stove, the more efficiently it will run and the safer and more reliable it will be.
